Reserve and purchase tickets by calling Saron 360/532-4611 or the day of Oktoberfest you can get them at the door.

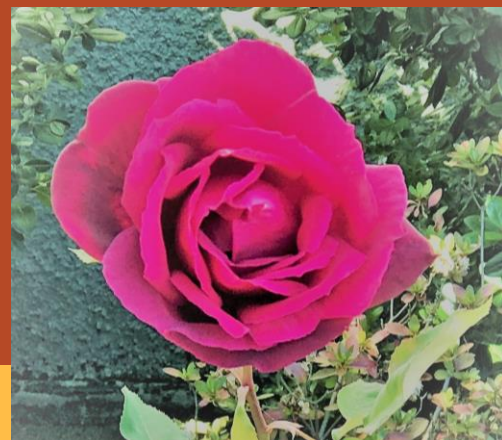

Over the winter we will be raising funds to replace the siding on the parsonage. We have received some bids that start at \$22,000.00 and go up from there. We are hoping to raise enough funds and recruit enough manpower that in the spring or summer of next year we can accomplish this task or at least part of it ourselves.

So here's a way you can help, 1 board at a time!!

Hardi Plank siding 8x12 ft, need approximately 322 Price is \$9.00 a board
Tyvek Homewrap, need 5 rollsPrice is approximately \$ 57.00 per roll
Caulking, need about 12 tubes Price is approximately \$7.50 a tube
Flashing Tape, need approximately 7 rolls Price is approximately \$22.00 a roll
1x4 needed for trim around windows Price is approximately \$3.00 a board ft
Paint for house after siding is on..... We'd say approximately 10 gallons house & 2 gallons trim.
Behr Premium Plus Ultra Satin approximately \$38.00 a gallon
