Elevator Update:

Our elevator is subject to a Consumer Product Safety Commission recall. Analysis has determined that the mechanisms are fully functional, however, a safety braking device—mandated by that recall—is required. The manufacturer, Waupaca Elevator, is producing those as quickly as they are able. We are in line to receive that part in August and it will be installed as soon as our regional service company, Olympic Elevator, can do so.
