As you may recall, our elevator is subject to a Consumer Product Safety Commission recall. Analysis has determined that the mechanisms are fully functional, however, a safety braking device—mandated by that recall—is required. The manufacturer, Waupaca Elevator, has sent the part but Olympic Elevator (our regional elevator company) will not install it at the price Waupaca is willing to pay. Waupaca is making arrangements with another regional elevator company to provide the installation, but that Kirkland company is currently scheduled out through November, so our patience is still necessary...
