Holiday Giving Opportunities & Outreach

We are in unprecedented times where ministry cannot happen how we have done it in years past. But we are the church and knowing all of you we still want to help our neighbors. Council, along with Pastor Michelle, talked about ways we can specifically give back to the community this year and support our neighbors in need. Below are the ways during Thanksgiving and Christmas we are encouraging all to participate in helping.

Card Exchange. Would you like to help give some holiday cheer to another church member? Sign up to be a "secret pen pal" this holiday season all the way to Easter. You would be assigned another person in the church to send a card to and sign it your "secret pen pal." The idea is we send a couple over the next few months and on Easter you send your last card with your name signed into it. Inside the card include a Bible verse you love or a little prayer. Chaplains on the Harbor Fundraiser for a Food Truck. Chaplains on the Harbor that has partnered with Saron and 1st Presbyterian in the past is raising funds for a food truck. They have even, during the pandemic, used our 1st Presbyterian kitchen to prepare meals that are handed out on Sunday evenings in Aberdeen. Currently, they feed between 120-150 people each Sunday. With a food truck, they would be able to increase the number of meals and be able to reach more people than their current location allows. They are hoping to serve meals in a variety of locations in Grays Harbor County reaching more of our hungry neighbors, while also providing pastoral care and help. During COVID this is especially important, because of the hunger spike that has happened to families with school-age children. In addition, on days the ministry is off, they can use the food truck to generate income to provide money to keep the program going. If you would like to help support this ministry write a check out to Saron Lutheran-First Presbyterian Church and put in the memo line "food truck." We would like to write one check to them at Christmas from our congregation.

Adoption of 4 Local Families for Christmas. Pastor Michelle will be reaching out to the local school district to help 4 local families with providing gifts. This year, due to COVID, we are asking for only cash and check donations to the church. This is the safest way to help families during this time. The donations will be divided up to the families and each family will receive a gift card from Amazon, Safeway, and Walmart. Please no physical gifts this year, because we are trying to keep the families and our staff safe.

COMFORT COOKING THROUGH COVID

Chicken and Rice Casserole

1 cup uncooked rice
1 can cream of mushroom soup
1 can cream of celery soup
1 soup can of water
1 envelope of dry Lipton Onion Soup Mix
1/4 cup chopped fresh parsley
8 Chicken thighs

Heat your oven to 350°. Grease a 9x13 baking pan with a cooking spray or vegetable oil.

Mix the first 5 ingredients together and pour them into your baking pan. Take the chicken thighs and nestle them into the soup and rice mixture. Make sure the chicken gets all covered up.

Cover your pan tightly with foil.

Bake for 2 hours. Take the foil off the pan and cook 15-20 minutes longer to brown. Sprinkle the parsley on the casserole just before serving.

NOTE: You may add ½ cup chopped celery and ½ cup chopped red bell peppers if you wish.

Team 2 will be organizing the *December* meal for the UGM Dinner.

Our Union Gospel Mission teams need YOU!

Here is a current list of the teams and list of dates each team is serving. You will see that <u>we can use more volunteers!</u> If you are unsure about whether to volunteer, keep in mind that each team prepares and delivers a meal to the mission <u>only</u> three time a year, just once every four months. (During the Covid crisis, we are no longer serving the meal...just providing it.) The date of the meal is always the third Monday of the month. The meal consists of a main dish (traditionally Tator-Tot Casserole from the Saron cookbook), bread, salad or seasonal fruit, dessert, and beverage (milk and juice). The teams pick a menu and divide up the jobs: 3-4 for main dish, someone for milk/juice, someone for bread, someone for salad, and dessert. 
