Dear Church,

I write this as we are getting a huge downpour of rain these beginning days of June. Summer is almost here even if the weather outside is not reflecting that. We have lots of joyful things happening this summer! The Gospel Garden (community garden) ministry is up and running again, we have Lutherwood Family Camp in July, and our joint Vacation Bible School with Amazing Grace in a few weeks. We also have on August 10th a BBQ event scheduled as a major fundraiser for the West Wall project that is open to the entire community.

A little update on the West Wall project: As of June 3<sup>rd</sup>, we have raised \$37,934.73 of the \$75,000 needed to match the funds of the anonymous donor to fix the wall. The contractors are hoping the fix will begin by mid-June. If you feel called to donate, please do so sooner, so we can get this work begun in the lovely warm months coming.

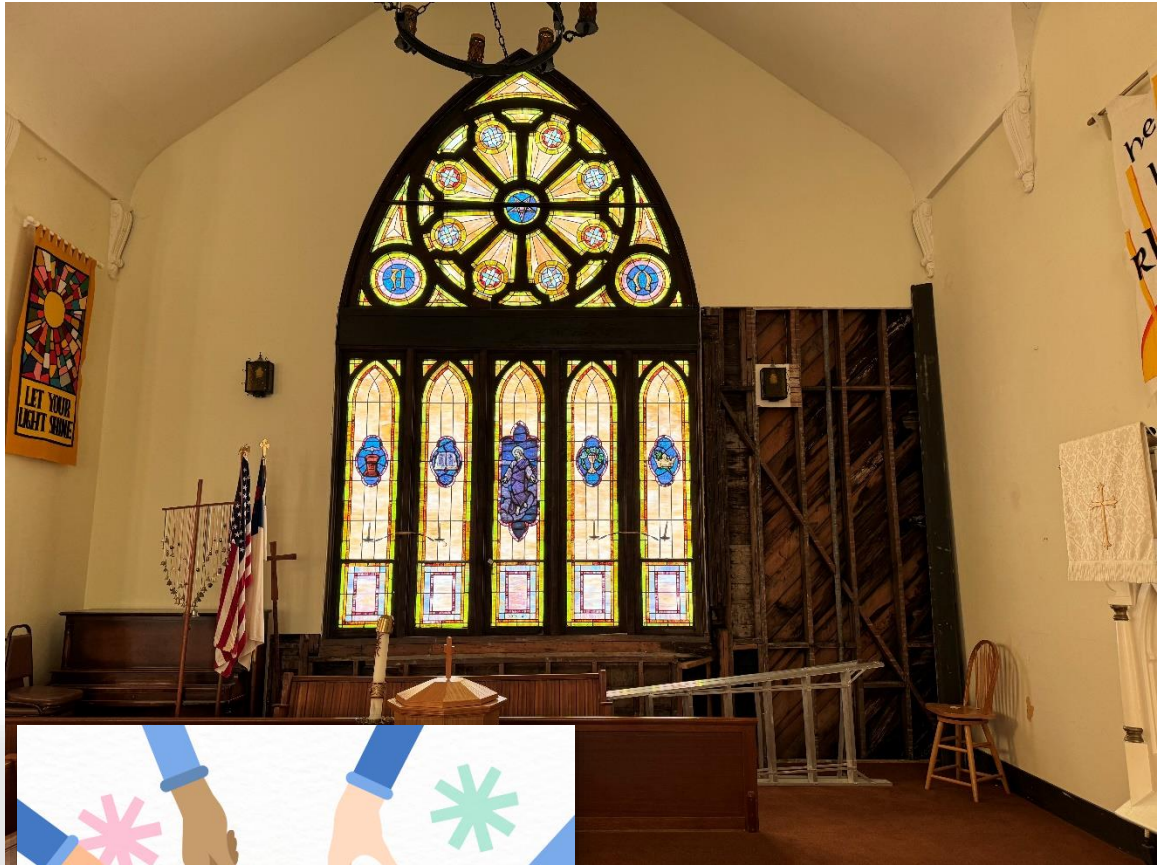

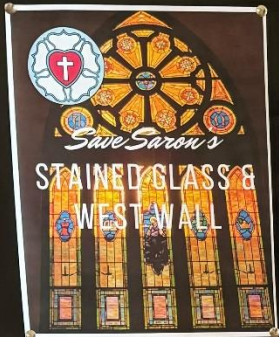

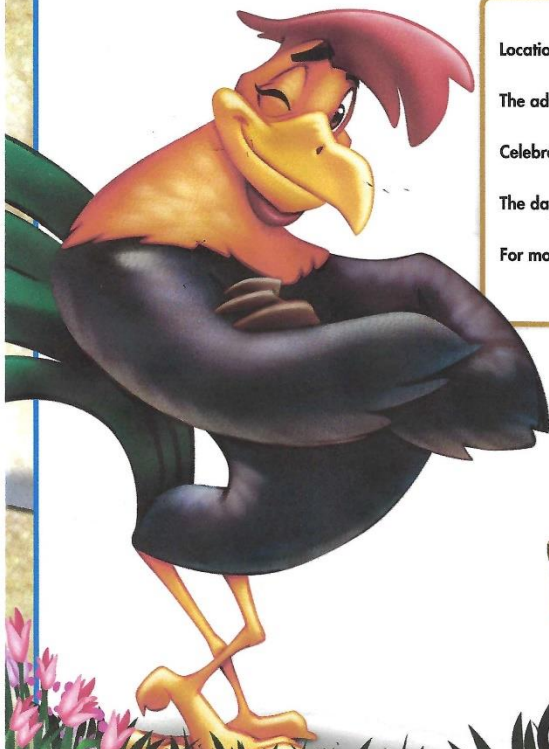
## John Rhodes' Book

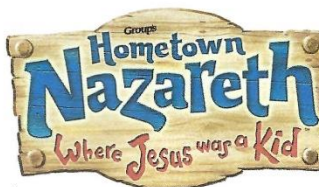
